Masterclass with Dominique Goblet

Going up – Going down – The Mountain

4 – 8 April 2022

ABOUT THE ARTIST

Dominique Goblet was born in 1967 in Brussels and studied illustration at the Institut St-Luc. Between intimacy and fiction, she questions narrative and storytelling, proposing random and sequential arrangements of stories, real dialogues in images. In 2019, she chaired the Angoulême Grand Jury and was 2020 honoured with the Grand Prix Töpffer (Switzerland) and the Atomium Prize (Belgium) for her body of work.

During the MASTERCLASS, students will approach a narrative work with multiple dimensions. They will play with the narrative format, its interpretations, its poetic codes and try to extend the boundaries of the field of classical comics/illustration.

Reversing the stereotypes of the medium, students are asked to question forms of contemporary comics, drawing and/or painting. The final presentation, the hanging or the montage will allow for a multitude of links and connections, debunking our linear sequential habits. (Everyone is free to adapt this work to an editorial purpose.)

WHO CAN APPLY?

Students and recent graduates from HSLU–Art & Design and our partner schools. The number of participants is limited.

MATERIALS

- No eraser!!
- A4 sheets (printer paper) and more robust paper (± 200–250gr/m²)
- Black drawing tools: bic, felt pen, pen (ball), ink. Various thicknesses are welcome (0,35/ 0,5 /round leads, flat leads...), but not essential
- Colour: students are free to bring any colour material of their choice.

PREPARATION

Students are asked to prepare a documentation or personal image bank of mountains (on paper or on digital files). These might be videos or photos (from family albums, old or current), a personal selection if possible with additional elements of a more classical documentation.



HOW TO SUBMIT?

Please, send applications as a low-resolution PDF, which will include

- name, age, school, email and address for correspondence and phone number, status as student or alumni, earlier publications
- excerpt of former and/or current comic project (legible sketches with superimposed text accepted)

Deadline is **Monday, March 14th 2022.**

Once accepted, participants will confirm their commitment to attend. The course will be held in English and French.
